Pursuant to the Department of Defense Acquisition Improvement Program which is intended to reduce the size and cost of individual solicitations and provide industry with simplified solicitation and award documents, the Defense Supply Center Columbus is issuing this Master Solicitation which will apply to solicitations issued after August 1, 2000.

The Master Solicitation is applicable to those solicitations, offers and awards that reference it. The contractor should retain a copy of this Master for ready reference when responding to a solicitation or when performing on an award. In some instances clauses will be incorporated by reference; however those having no bearing on the instant acquisition become self-deleting.
